Panel Competition Rules

Printed Images

Maximum 3 Entries

1. The photography should reflect the theme, this being a panel competition it is expected that the images will be “three on a theme”, i.e. three individual prints based upon a shared theme.
2. Subject matter is open.
3. Entries may have been taken at any time / any year.
4. Entries may be cropped and / or manipulated to the photographer’s discretion.
5. Entries must not be extensively modified. For example where the original image may not be wholly recognisable or the image may be considered photo-art. The judge will be asked to discern this.
6. The photographer must hold copyright over all components of the photograph.
7. Judges will be asked to comment on Sharpness, Focus, and Handling of Colour & Composition with further comments at the judge’s discretion. Each entry will be scored out of 20 points.
8. Entries may be produced conventionally or digitally.
9. Prints may be any size.
10. Mounts need to be 500 x 400mm.
11. All entries **must** be titled on the reverse.
12. The authors name **must not** appear on the print or reverse thereof.
13. Entries should not previously have been entered into a panel competition, entries consisting of images from previous club competitions are permitted.
14. The judge’s decision is final.
